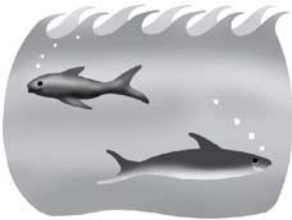


Basic Water Intelligence

Salt Water: Water that contains a relatively high percentage of salt minerals (oceans, seas, some lakes and rivers).

_____ % of the Earth's water is salt water.



Ice: Frozen water (glaciers, ice caps).

_____ % of the Earth's water is ice.



Ground Water: Water stored underground in rock crevices and in the pores of geologic materials that make up the Earth's crust.

_____ % of the Earth's water is ground water.



Surface Water: Water that is on the Earth's surface, such as in a stream, river, lake, swamp, creek or reservoir.

_____ % of the Earth's water is surface water.
